Private transfer to your hotel situated in the heart of Old Accommodation is at the comfortable Seville Hotel. Visits include a cigar factory and also the Havana Club Rum factory. A fascinating walking tour through the delights of the old city centre and a ride back in time in an old pre-revolution (1959) American car. Drive from Havana East through sugar plantations to Trinidad. Visit the resting place of Che Guevara and Ernest Hemmingway's home. Stay in the delightful Iberostar Hotel situated in the historic town centre. On to Cienfuegos, a city known as Pearl of the South due to its large boulevards, fascinating buildings and spectacular views over the bay. Dine in Palacio Del Valle, a stunning Moorishstyle palace. Depart for Pinar Del Rio province, Cuba's main tobacco growing region. Stop at Guama to take a boat through the mangrove swamps to a replica stilted Taino Indian village on the shores of Treasure Lake. Continue to Vinales, to stay in Casa Particular's (Spanish for 'private house') normally run by Cuban families -a great chance to interact with the locals. Day7 we visit the famous Vinales Valley and experience how Cuba's famous cigars are still handmade. There will be a subterranean boat ride through the El Indio limestone cave system. We will depart to Las Terrazas community, situated in the foothills of the Sierra del Rosario Ecological Reserve, then return to Havana.
